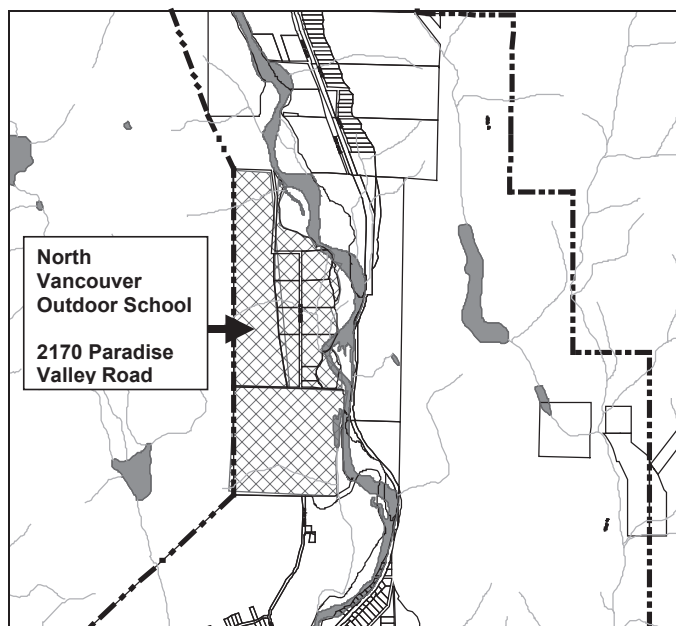

NOTICE is hereby given that Council of the District of Squamish will hold a **PUBLIC HEARING** in the Council Chambers at the District of Squamish Municipal Hall, 37955 Second Avenue, Squamish, British Columbia on Tuesday, **May 26, 2009 at 7:00 p.m.** to hear and receive representations from persons who believe that their interest in property is affected by the following proposed amendment to the Zoning Bylaw.

- Item #1:** "District of Squamish Zoning Bylaw No. 1342, 1995, Amendment Bylaw (Comprehensive Development No. 58 Zone) No. 2065, 2008"
- Applicant:** McFarland Marceau Architects Ltd.
- Affected Lands:** 2170 Paradise Valley Road
(North Vancouver Outdoor School)
- Proposal:** To rezone the North Vancouver Outdoor School site to better reflect the educational activities on the property
- Proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment:** To amend the Zoning Bylaw to rezone the subject lands from Resource (RE) and Tourist Commercial (C-3) to Comprehensive Development Zone No. 58 (CD -58) to better reflect the current and future educational activities on the property, consisting of three Blocks A, B and C and include Agriculture, Fish Hatchery, Educational and Research Activities, School, Assembly, Accessory Sleeping Unit, Accessory Uses and Accessory Residential Dwelling
