Applying FireSmart preventative measures can help reduce the risk of fire damage to your property. To help showcase these standards, the Squamish Emergency Program and community partners will 'FireSmart' one property in Paradise Valley.

The crew will come in advance and FireSmart one half of the property.

On September 6, all Squamish residents will be invited to the property to see the 'before and after' and discuss FireSmart with SEP and community partners from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. During the event, SEP will hold a barbecue and provide burgers, hotdogs and beverages for everyone who attends. The crew will return to complete the work.
