How can you assist snow clearing?

The District of Squamish Operations Department is requesting residents' assistance in providing the safest possible road conditions this winter season.

Please park vehicles in your driveway, or well off the roadside, during times of snowfall, to facilitate plowing/sanding operations. By assisting the District in facilitating snow removal, we are able to provide safer driving conditions for our residents and visitors, as well as access for emergency vehicles.

District of Squamish Traffic Regulation By-Law No. 779 provides the municipality with authorization to tow those vehicles which prevent the snowplow or sanding equipment access to the roadsides. The District requests residents assist the crews in doing their job by complying with the bylaw.

Financial Reporting for Beer Garden Permits

All Beer Garden Permit holders are required to forward a written financial breakdown of the revenues/expenditures and subsequent donation to community groups in the District of Squamish. Financial report forms are available at the Brennan Park Recreation Centre office. Financial Beer Garden Reports must be received in writing within 30 days from the date of the actual Beer Garden Permit and failure to submit such written reports may result in the withdrawal or denial of any 2010 Beer Garden Permit Approvals. No other form of Financial Reporting will be accepted. Please return the completed forms to the Director of Recreation, Parks and Tourism, Box 310, Squamish, B.C.
