The District uses the Provincial Voters' List for its list of eligible electors. If you are not on this list, please visit Election's BC website to register. You can also register to vote at the poll on Election day. Please bring identification showing residence and a signature with you.

If you are thinking of running for one of these positions, you may obtain a nomination package from Municipal Hall after August 29. It will contain all of the information that you need in order to submit your nomination. Please be aware that you will need to have 2 registered voters to support your nomination. The nomination period runs from 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 30 to 4:00 p.m. on Friday, October 10. Please contact the Chief Election Officer at Municipal Hall, if you require additional information.

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

NOTICE is hereby given that Council of the District of Squamish will hold a PUBLIC HEARING in the Council Chambers at the District of Squamish Municipal Hall, 37955 Second Avenue, Squamish, British Columbia on Tuesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. to hear and receive representations from persons who believe that their interest in property is affected by the following proposed amendments to the Zoning Bylaw.

The proposed bylaws will be considered separately at the hearing in the following order:

Item #1: "District of Squamish Zoning Bylaw No. 1342, 1995, Amendment Bylaw (37803/37813 Second Avenue) No. 2045, 2008".

Applicant: Schmidt Architecture.

Affected Lands: 37803/37813 Second Avenue (north west corner at 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Vancouver Street)

Proposal: To rezone the subject property to accommodate Artisan Village (C-10) uses.

Proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment: To amend the Zoning Bylaw to rezone the subject land from Light Industrial (I-1) to Artisan Village (C-10) to allow for future development of a broad mix of uses including accessory uses; accessory retail sales; restaurant; artisan; home occupation; retail store; business office use; apartment dwelling; arts and culture and off-street parking and loading.

Item #2: "District of Squamish Zoning Bylaw No. 1342, 1995, Amendment Bylaw (Garibaldi Village Phase II) No. 2047, 2008"

Applicant: Wensley Architect

Affected Lands: Three lots to the north of the Garibaldi Village (Canadian Tire) site fronting onto Diamond Road (Lots A, B and C Plan 15617).

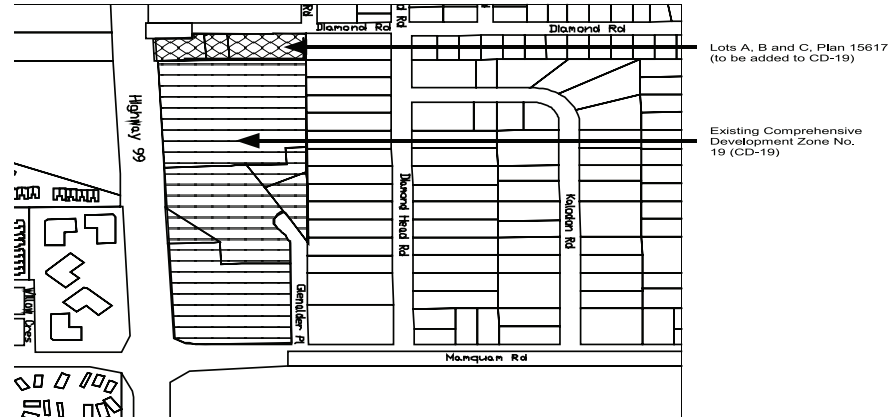
Proposal: To rezone the 3 lots from Multiple Family Residential (RM-2) to Comprehensive Development Zone No. 19 (CD-19) and to amend the text of the CD-19 zone.

Proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendment: To rezone Lots A, B and C Plan 15617 to Comprehensive Development Zone No. 19 (CD-19) to accommodate Phase 2 of the Garibaldi Village site, and further amend the text of the CD-19 zone to:

- delete residential as a permitted use;
- allow for up to 20,000 sq ft of second storey office space; and
- increase the allowable commercial square footage for retail and restaurant uses from 131,575 sq ft to 162,971 sq ft

Enquiries regarding the proposed amendment bylaws may be made to the Planning Department at 604.815.5002.

Persons who deem that their interest in property is affected by the proposed bylaws will have an opportunity to be heard and to present written submissions at the Public Hearing or, if unable to attend, may deliver a written submission to the Director of Administrative Services by 4:00 p.m. on the date of the Public Hearing. All submissions will form part of the public record.

**Council will not consider submissions received after the close of the Public Hearing.**
