

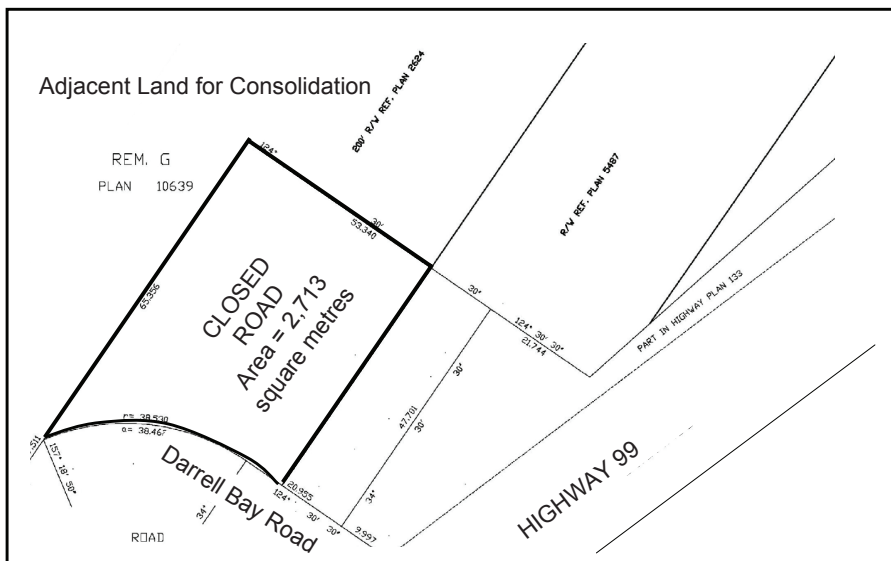
DISTRICT OF SQUAMISH

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ROAD CLOSURE AND LAND DISPOSITION

The District of Squamish gives notice of its intention to close to traffic and remove the dedication of a 2,713 square metre more or less portion of Darrell Bay Road labeled "Closed Road" on the sketch plan below.

Council will consider adoption of District of Squamish Road Closure Bylaw (Darrell Bay Road) 2061, 2008, closing the Highway Right of Way and removing its dedication at its Regular Meeting at Municipal Hall, 37955 Second Avenue, on Tuesday July 29th at 6:00 p.m. Persons who consider they are affected by the bylaw will be provided an opportunity to make representations to Council at that meeting or by delivering a written submission to the Director of Administrative Services by 1:00 p.m. on that date.

The District of Squamish also gives notice that if Council adopts the Bylaw, the District of Squamish intends to sell in fee simple the Closed Road to the owner of the adjoining lands for the purpose of consolidating the Closed Road with adjacent parcel legally described as PID: 009-325-247, Block G, Except: Firstly, Part in Explanatory Plan 8207, Secondly: Part on Highway Plan 71 Thirdly, Portions on Highway Plan 133 District Lot 608 Group 1, New Westminster District Plan 10639. SQUAMISH IS BEAR COUNTRY

HELP REDUCE HUMAN/BEAR CONFLICT BY:

- Keeping garbage inside or in a bear-proof container.
- Removing fruit from trees and bushes as it ripens.

- Hang birdfeeders, so they are inaccessible to bears or only feed birds over the winter, keep the area under the birdfeeder clear of seeds.



CAMPERS

- Store ALL FOOD and WILDLIFE ATTRACTANTS in a hard-sided vehicle/trailer/motor home (not in a tent or tent-trailer) when not in use/when not at the campsite/ and store inside overnight

WILDLIFE ATTRACTANTS INCLUDE:

- food and condiments • coolers - full/empty • dishes/pots • tablecloths
- toiletries/suntan lotion/insect spray • campstoves/barbeques • pet food/bowls
- garbage/wrappings/plastic bags • bottles/cans -full/empty
