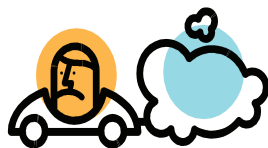
Strategy Session

Hotel Tax

Council supported in principle the additional hotel tax and requested the Squamish Sustainability Corporation bring forward a report on the status of the tax before the end of April.

Anti-Idling Bylaw



Council will review anti-idling bylaw information and direct staff to draft an anti-idling bylaw for implementation after a provincially funded anti-idling campaign is completed in the summer of 2008.

Development Permits

West Coast Railway Park Roundhouse

Council authorized the issuance of Development Permit No. 284 to the District of Squamish on behalf of the West Coast Railway Park.



3210 Mamquam Road Quest Apartments

Council authorized the issuance of Development Permit NO. 279 to the Sea to Sky Foundation with conditions including bonding for landscaping, resolution of Department of Fisheries issues, and discharge of the geotechnical covenant.

Council authorized issuance of Development Permit No. 280 to Sea to Sky Foundation with conditions including bonding of landscaping, resolution of Department of Fisheries issues, and discharge of the geotechnical covenant.

The District of Squamish Council gave first three readings to District of Squamish Subdivision and Development Control Bylaw No. 2041, 2008.

Council approved the adoption of District of Squamish Zoning Bylaw No. 1342, 1995, Amendment Bylaw (40504 Government Road RM-2) No. 1983, 2007.

Council approved the adoption of District of Squamish 40504 Government Road Housing Bylaw No. 2038, 2008.

Public Hearing

District of Squamish Zoning Bylaw No. 1342, 1995, Amendment Bylaw (Elements Phase 2) No. 2015, 2008 was given third reading. The amendment is to rezone those parcels of land at 39887 Government Road from Residential 2 (RS-2) Zone to Multiple Family Residential 2 (RM-2) Zone.
