## NOTICE OF ELECTION BY VOTING

### SQUAMISH VOTES NOVEMBER 15!

Don't miss your opportunity to VOTE to elect one Mayor, six Councillors and two School Trustees to represent Squamish for a three year term:

**November 15, 2008 General Voting Day**  
**Brennan Park Recreation Centre Auditorium**  
**8:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.**  
**1009 Centennial Way, Squamish**

**Remember: No signs, flyers, buttons or election talk!** It is an offence to display campaign material or to influence a voter within 100 metres of a Voting Place.

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by producing two pieces of identification (one must have your signature) to prove both residency and identity, completing the required application form and swearing you are:

- 18 years of age or older; and
- a Canadian citizen (no landed immigrants or corporations); and
- resident of BC for at least six months immediately preceding voting day; and
- resident of OR non-resident registered owner of real property in the District of Squamish for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; and not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Acceptable ID includes:

- BC Driver's Licence
- BC Identification Card
- BC Gold Care Card
- Social Insurance Card
- Utility Bill
- ICBC Vehicle Insurance Documents
- BC Care Card
- Citizenship Card
- Financial Institution Credit Card
- District of Squamish Property Tax Notice

To register, non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity and a non-resident property elector certificate issued by the Chief Election Officer at the Municipal Hall prior to voting or at the voting place by providing:

- two pieces of identification (one must have your signature);
- proof of ownership of the property (e.g. recent copy of the Land Title Search Certificate available from the Government Agent or agencies with BC Online or the Certificate of Indefeasible Title); and
- written consent from the majority of all of the owners stating that you are the one owner who is designated as the Non-Resident (Property) Elector for that property.

### SQUAMISH LILLOOET REGIONAL DISTRICT AREA D

SLRD Area D Director voting will also be available at Brennan Park Recreation Centre for residents of Area D. To determine in which election you can vote, confirm if you are a resident of the District of Squamish or the Squamish Lillooet Regional District Area D by checking your tax notice or calling Municipal Hall. Residents of Britannia Beach, Ring Creek, Squamish Valley, Black Tusk/Pine Crest and Furry Creek are residents of Area D and vote in the SLRD election for an Area D Director; NOT in the District of Squamish election for Mayor, Council, or Trustee.

### HELP FOR PERSONS NEEDING ASSISTANCE

Persons needing assistance to mark their ballot due to a physical disability or difficulties with reading or writing may:

- bring a person to assist or ask for help from an election official.
- bring a translator to read the ballot and instructions for voting.

Before providing assistance you must first swear and sign a declaration to not influence the voter.

**Voting places are wheelchair accessible.** If you can make it to the voting place but are unable to enter due to physical disability, have someone come into the voting place and ask for "curb side assistance". Election officials will bring a ballot to your vehicle at the curb outside of the voting place, wait while you mark the ballot, and deposit the ballot in the vote tabulating unit in the Voting Place.

### Financial Reporting for Beer Garden Permits

All Beer Garden Permit Holders are required to forward a financial report with the financial breakdown for the revenues/expenditures and subsequent donation to community groups to the District of Squamish. Financial report forms are available for pick-up at the Brennan Park Recreation Centre office. The financial report must be received in writing within 30 days from date of the actual Beer Garden Permit and failure to submit such written report may result in the withdrawal or denial of any 2009 Beer Garden Permit approvals. No other form of financial reporting will be accepted.
