## SOLTERRA DONATION TO DISTRICT OF SQUAMISH- Cheque Presentation

## SOCIO ECONOMIC FISCAL IMPACT STUDY AWARDED

Council awarded the Socio Economic and Fiscal Impact Study regarding Garibaldi at Squamish to MMK Consulting Inc. provided that Garibaldi at Squamish pay the full cost of the study in advance.

## SQUAMISH OCEANFRONT DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FINANCING

District of Squamish provided a letter to the Squamish Oceanfront Development Corporation supporting the \$500,000 increase in credit, and the extension of the Line of Credit supplied by Pacific and Western Bank beyond the December 31, 2008 maturity date.

## 2008 COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT GRANT REQUEST

Council approved a Community Enhancement Grant in the amount of \$975.00 to Howe Sound Secondary School Career Programs, to assist in the cost of sending three students to the RCMP Youth Academy 2009.

Council approved a Community Enhancement Grant in the amount of \$1,825.64 to West Coast Railway Association, to assist with property tax costs on subleased property.

## SQUAMISH/VANCOUVER COMMUTER BUS SERVICE FEASIBILITY STUDY

Council approved sole sourcing UMA Engineering to conduct a feasibility study regarding a Squamish/Vancouver Commuter Bus Service.

## PATRON PARTICIPATION ENTERTAINMENT ENDORSEMENT TO LCLB

1. The Nest – Application to Liquor Control and Licensing Board (LCLB) for Patron Participation Entertainment Endorsement

Council recommended that the LCLB make a permanent change to Food Primary Licence, Licence Number 133771 specifically to offer

patron participation by way of a Patron Participation Entertainment Endorsement at The Nest Restaurant, located at 41340 Government Road, Brackendale, BC

2. Cafeteria at Quest University Canada – Application to Liquor Control and Licensing Board (LCLB) for Patron Participation Entertainment Endorsement

Council recommended that the LCLB make a permanent change to Food Primary Licence, Licence Number 303148 specifically to offer patron participation by way of a Patron Participation Entertainment Endorsement at the Cafeteria at Quest University Canada, located at 3200 University Boulevard, Garibaldi Highlands, Squamish, BC.

**(A Patron Participation Entertainment Endorsement would permit dancing, karaoke, etc.)**

## DEVELOPMENT PERMIT No. 286 – 40238 Glenalder Place – GARIBALDI VILLAGE PHASE II

(The proposed development is a mixed commercial and office complex with associated parking and loading areas).

Council authorized issuance of Development Permit No. 286, issued to Garibaldi Shopping Centre Ltd. at 40238 Glenalder Place.
